To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 80,714 for 120 acres in favor of George Varner, Private, Captain Reynolds's Company, Georgia Militia, Seminole War,

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the East half of the Northeast quarter, and the North west quarter of the North east quarter, of Section Twenty nine, in Township Forty one, of Range thirty, in the District of lands subject to sale at Warsaw Missouri, containing One hundred and twenty acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said Warrant having been assigned by the said George Varner to Harvey Fellows, in whose favor said tract has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Harvey Fellows, as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Harvey Fellows as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
